Fitness Centers	50% capacity and adequate 6 feet spacing of people and equipment, groups limited to distancing, , other reasonable measures for health and hygiene	May 28 thru June 17
Malls	50% capacity and adequate 6 feet spacing, common seating areas like food courts closed, restaurants in food court can be carry out only, play areas closed, other reasonable measures for health and hygiene	May 28 thru June 17
Salons (cosmetology, electrology, esthetics, nails, manicuring, pedicuring)	50% capacity and adequate 6 feet spacing, appointment only with no public waiting/gathering, other reasonable measures for health and hygiene	May 28 thru June 17

Outdoor Performance Venues	(Closed until June 1) Grandstands/permanent seating limited to 50% capacity and adequate 6 feet spacing, other reasonable measures for health and hygiene	June 1 thru June 17
Casino and Gaming Facilities	(Closed until June 1 except for non-spectator race tracks) 50% capacity and adequate 6 feet spacing of games or barriers installed, follow restaurant/bars requirements for food and beverage with no self service food, other reasonable measures for health and hygiene	June 1 thru June 17

Farmers Markets	Farm products/food only, Entertainment and activities prohibited, common seating eliminated, vendors spacing at least 6 feet apart, social distancing, hygiene, and public health measures	June 1 thru June 17
Auctions	50% indoor or outdoor capacity and proper social distancing	June 1 thru June 17
Schools	Reopen for school-sponsored activities and learning effective June 1, 2020, but only to the extent that such activities and learning are consistent with guidance of the Iowa Department of Education, the Iowa High School Athletic Association, and the Iowa Girls High School Athletic Union, as applicable. Any such school-sponsored activity that is conducted consistent with this guidance shall not be a violation of the prohibition on certain mass gatherings under this Proclamation	June 1 on
