Program Overview

Expanded transportation services through the Sioux City Transit System's **Nights & Weekends Program** give eligible riders greater access to mobility, enriched quality of life, and increased options for affordable transportation outside of transit hours of operation.

Paratransit Certified passengers are qualified to benefit from this **Americans with Disabilities Act** enhanced service. Eligible riders may purchase the vouchers at the Transit Dispatch Office located at 505 Nebraska Street.

Human Services agencies and other community-based organizations interested in arranging group travel should contact directly the vendor of their choosing to negotiate prices for five or more persons.

Voucher Information

- ◆ There is no limit on the number of vouchers that may be purchased.**
- ◆ Vouchers can be used Monday through Saturday after 6:00 PM & before 6:00 AM, and any time on Sunday.
- ◆ Trips must be within the corporate limits of Sioux City, IA, North Sioux City, SD, Sergeant Bluff, IA or South Sioux City, NE.
- ◆ A passenger must contact the vendor directly to arrange ride.
- ◆ Please inform vendor if you are traveling with a companion. As with Paratransit Administrative Rules, a companion may ride at no additional charge.

How to Obtain ADA Paratransit Certification

A comprehensive application process is conducted to determine whether an individual's disability qualifies for alternative Paratransit service. The following documents are necessary:

1. Medicare Card (if applicable)
2. State Department of Human Services Medical Assistance Eligibility card
3. Doctor's letter verifying the disability and need
4. Completed Paratransit Application including verification portion signed by a medical doctor.

A follow up interview will be conducted by Sioux City Transit. Applicants will be notified upon qualification.

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
